Measures to Prevent Heat Stroke Accidents in School Educational Activities, etc.

We would like to express our deepest gratitude to all parents and guardians for your continued understanding and cooperation with the educational administration of our city.

Since April 2024, the government has issued a "Heat Stroke Special Alert" when the temperature becomes extremely high and there is a risk of serious health problems due to heat stroke.

Therefore, we will take the following measures to prevent heat stroke accidents in school educational activities. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Note

- Response to "Heat Stroke Special Alert" (since 2024)
 - (1) On class days and kindergarten school days
 - ⇒"The school will be closed."

- (2) For summer holidays and weekends
 - ⇒"All club activities will be canceled." "All events will be canceled or postponed."
- *When the highest value of the heat index (WBGT) is expected to reach 35 or higher at all observation points in the prefecture, a special heat stroke alert will be issued by the Ministry of the Environment (around 14:00 on the previous day).
- 2 Response to "Heat Stroke Alert" (since 2024)
 - ⇒ "The school/kindergarten will consider changing the location or content of the activity, or canceling or postponing the activity."
 - *When the highest value of the heat index (WBGT) is expected to reach 33 or higher at any of the observation points in the prefecture, the Ministry of the Environment will issue a heat stroke alert (around 5:00 p.m. on the previous day and around 5:00 a.m. on the day of the event).
 - *Schools and kindergartens will notify students, kindergartners, and parents/guardians of decisions regarding implementation, changes in content, cancellation, postponement, etc., of various events, etc., via school e-mail distribution, etc., as necessary.
- 3 Response based on heat index (WBGT) (already notified)
 - (1) When the heat index (WBGT) is 31 or higher at the activity location.
 - ⇒ "Exercise will be stopped."
 - (2) When the heat index (WBGT) is between 28 and 31 at the activity location
 - ⇒ "Due to the high risk of heat stroke, avoid strenuous exercise or exercise that easily raises the body temperature, and if necessary, discontinue exercise."
