

Guidelines for When Storm Warnings Are Issued

Please be informed that the following procedures will apply in such situations, and we ask for your understanding and cooperation. Please note that weather information broadcast on television, radio, etc. is provided by municipality/city.

I. When “Storm Warning(*Bofu Keiho*)” or “Special Warning(*Tokubetsu Keiho*)” is issued for Kameyama City

**Applicable Warnings**...Storm Warning (*Bofu Keiho*), Blizzard Warning (*Bofusetu Keiho*), Storm Special Warning (*Bofu Tokubetsu Keiho*), Blizzard Special Warning (*Bofusetu Tokubetsu Keiho*)  
**Level 5 Special Warning (*Tokubetsu Keiho*):** Heavy Rain(*Oame*), Heavy Snow(*Oyuki*),  
 River Flooding(*Kasen Hanran*), Landslide Disaster(*Dosha Saigai*)  
**Level 4 Danger Warning (*Kiken Keiho*):** Heavy Rain(*Oame*), River Flooding(*Kasen Hanran*), Landslide Disaster(*Dosha Saigai*)

※ “Level 5” corresponds to Emergency Safety Assurance, and “Level 4” corresponds to an Evacuation Order. In addition to following the school’s response measures, please also consider evacuating to shelters or other safe locations, and always prioritize safety in your actions.

【Warnings issued BEFORE 6:30 am】

Weather warning condition	School Responses
(1) Lifted before 6:30 am	Open with regular school hours.
(2) Continued as of 6:30 am	Students should stay home.
(3) Lifted between 6:30 am to 11:00 am	Afternoon class only. Lunch at home and come to school between 12:45~13:00. The 5 <sup>th</sup> period starts at 13:15.
(4) Continued after 11:00 am	No school. Students should remain home.

【Warning issued AFTER 6:30 am】

Weather warning condition	School Responses
(1) Issued before leaving home or being on their way to school	Stay home. If students are already on their way, head to school or home, whichever is closer.
(2) Issued while students are still in school	Suspension of Classes. Dismissed after confirming the safety of students’ way home. For students who are difficult to return home safely, teachers keep them wait in a safe place (in school etc.) and contact their parents or guardians.
(3) Lifted between 6:30 am to 11:00 am	Afternoon class only. Lunch at home and come to school between 12:45~13:00. The 5 <sup>th</sup> period starts at 13:15.
(4) Continued after 11:00 am	No school. Students should remain home.

2. Other Warnings and Advisories . . . Open with regular school hours.

3. When you are in danger or difficulty to go to school due to the disaster. (Landslide, Flooded/Washout bridge, Traffic interruption etc.)

... Stay home and notify the School of the situation. It is regarded as an inevitable suspension of attendance. (Absences are not counted.)

The above is the general rule, and is subject to change due to weather conditions or disaster situations. (e.g., No warning has been issued, but students may be sent home when a typhoon is approaching or other weather conditions worsen. In such cases, we will inform you by “Tsunagaru Renraku.”

If we have no morning classes or the school is dismissed before lunch due to warnings, etc., “School Lunches” will not be provided. Please be aware that no refunds for lunch will be made due to an emergency situation as foods have already been ordered.
